Enrollment

- * 2.75 GPA
- * For College Algebra you must score a 21 Math ACT or 70 Accuplacer
- * For English Comp you must score an 18 English ACT or 80 Accuplacer

Steps to Enroll

1. Talk to your counselor about what courses you would like to enroll in.
2. Complete placement testing (for Comp and College Alg only). Bring verification of your ACT score to your counselor, or sign up with Mrs. Bruna to take an Accuplacer test.

3. Complete the paper *Concurrent Credit Application Form* and return completed form to your counselor. (We will have Mr. Smith sign all completed applications at once.)

4. Submit payment for your class(es). You will be billed by SATC. Do NOT pay AHS!

Payment

- * \$79 per credit hour
- * 3 credit hours or less must be paid in full by the 1st of day of class, August 18th.
- * More than 3 credit hours qualify for a payment plan of 4 equal payments.
- * Jeffcoat Scholarship - if you are on free/reduced lunches, talk to your AHS counselor about local tuition assistance. ***This must be turned in with your application!***
