

District Compliance with Federal Regulations

In compliance with the Executive order 112-46; Title 2 of the Education Amendments of 1976, Title 6 of the Civil Rights Act of 1964, as amended by the Equal Opportunity Act of 1972, Section 504 of the Rehabilitation Act of 1973, and all other federal, state, and Abilene USD 435 laws, policies and regulation, Abilene USD 435 shall not discriminate on the basis of sex, race, color, national origin, age or handicap in the employment or educational activities operated by the district.
